

Microfiber as seen under a microscope

Did you know there is plastic in clothing?!

As stated in a previous "Tip Tuesday", there are several sources of microplastics, one of which is microfibers that are commonly found in clothing and released into the environment via washing machines.

Clean Ocean Action's [microplastic research](#) has shown microfibers in water samples (as seen in the photo). COA will release a report in summer 2016.

In an additional [study highlighting microfiber waste](#), ecologist Mark Browne noted, "By sampling waste-water from domestic washing machines, (I) estimated that around 1,900 individual fibers can be rinsed off a single synthetic garment - ending up in our oceans."

Dirty Laundry, Clean Ocean

Here are some great tips on how to reduce ocean pollution when you wash your laundry:



- Buy [eco-friendly detergents and softeners](#)
- When you use **soap flakes or powdered detergent**, add it to the washing machine *before the water and clothing have been added*
- Purchase **natural clothing**: 100 % organic cotton, linen, wool, hemp, silk
- **Hang-dry clothing**
- **Clean the lint trap** after every wash/dry cycle
